


Simple Search




1. Select a **search type** from the drop down list provided (All Fields, Abstract Description, Author, Title, Journal Title)
2. Enter **search word or phrase** in the box provided
 - ✘ You cannot type a list of words or connect words with Booleans (AND, NOT, OR). Use the 'Advanced Search' for this type of search.
 - ▶ Truncation is implied (e.g. the word *shop* will return results including *shop*, *shops*, *shopping*)
 - ▶ Invert author names (e.g. Sparks, Leigh)
3. Click the **search button** to begin 

Advanced Search



1. Enter **search word(s) or phrase(s)** in the box(es) provided
 - ▶ Truncation is implied (e.g. the word *shop* will return results including *shop*, *shops*, *shopping*)
 - ▶ Invert author names (e.g. Sparks, L)
 - ▶ Select a Boolean operator (AND, OR, or NOT) to combine search terms
2. Select a **document type** from the drop down list provided (All Fields, Abstract Description, Author, Title, Journal Title)
3. **Narrow your search** by typing further search terms, and selecting search types and Boolean operators
 - ▶ You can also narrow your search by typing in year(s) of publications.
 - ▶ Word number boundaries can be imposed to limit your search results. However this is only available for searches in newspaper or trade periodicals.
4. Click the **search button** to begin

Total No of Pages: 26 **Abstract:** The location of this study is Raploch, an area considered one of the most deprived neighbourhoods in Scotland. Raploch is an area situated within the town of Stirling. The objectives of this report are to ascertain the current position of existing Raploch retailers and to consider the optimum location and amount of floorspace in the Raploch area with consideration of future area and business plans. A qualitative study involving premises inspections and interviews with retail owners/managers, the report discusses common themes and key points of distinction rather than individual retailer profiles. A list of all retailers in the area is provided and findings are presented under the following headings: observation studies, functions performed, employment, trading/operating environment and business support. A number of repeated issues arose and suggestions to Stirling Council/Scottish Enterprise Forth Valley are offered as a means of addressing local retailer concerns.
